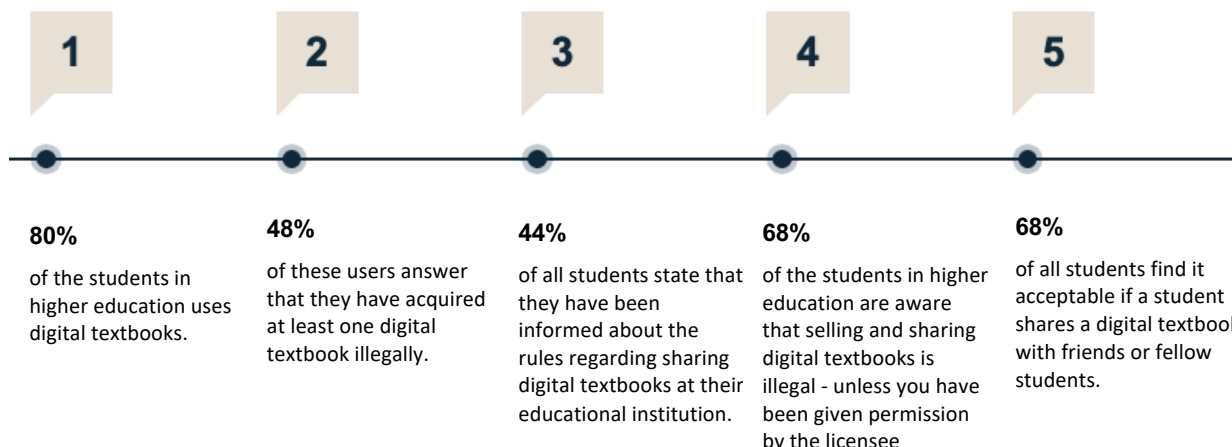
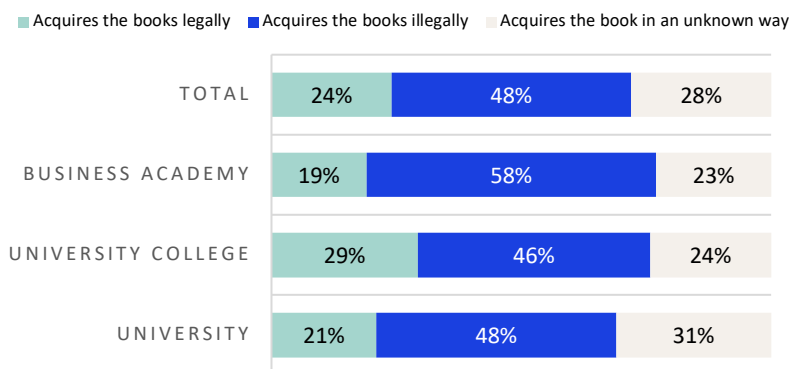

METHODS FOR ACQUIRING DIGITAL TEXTBOOKS



Illegal acquisition is extremely common among the students. Every other student (48%) in higher education who use digital textbooks have acquired a book illegally.

The illegal sharing of digital textbooks is still most widespread in the close study environment, i.e. among friends or fellow students. Among students who have received an illegal textbook via online platforms such as Facebook, Dropbox and Google Drive, 48% have received the book from a friend or fellow student.

Illegal acquisition is when the digital study book is acquired from: DBA, Gul & Gratis, Facebook, Messenger, Dropbox, Google Drive, or directly from someone from their place of education. Unknown acquisition cover methods that can be characterized as both legal and illegal.
