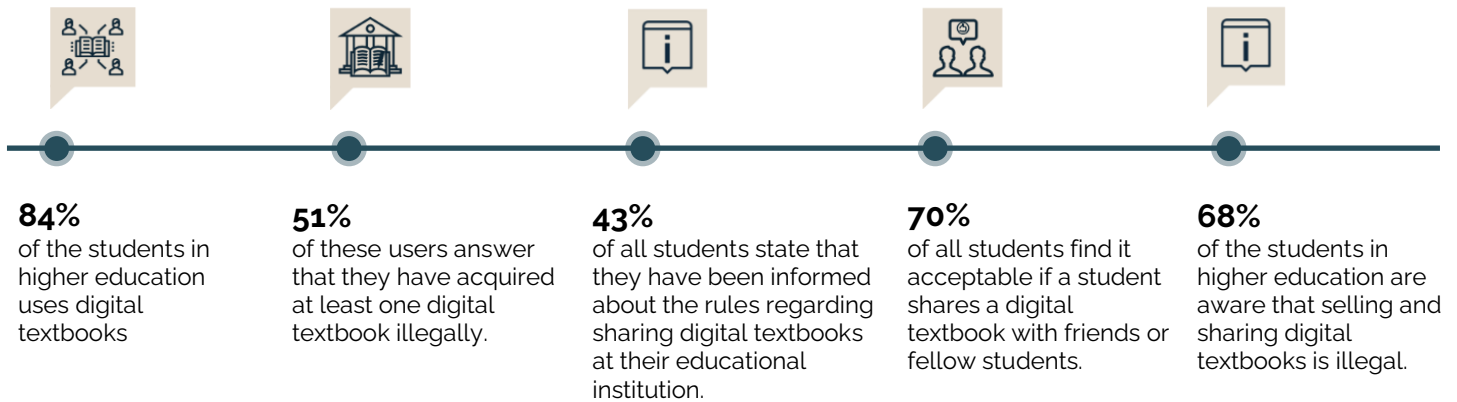
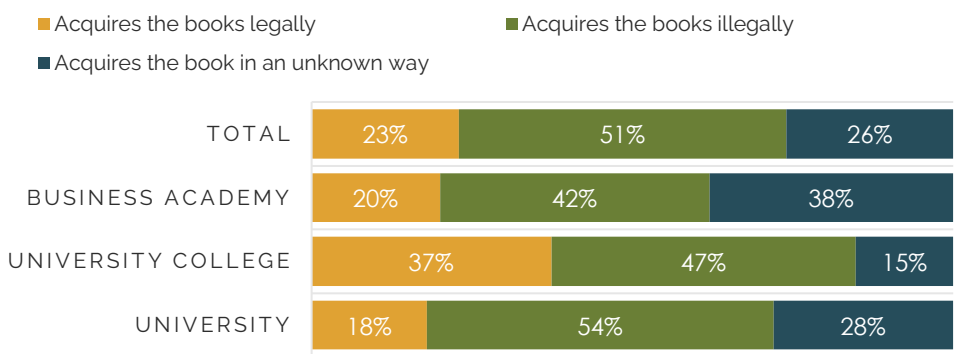


Survey of students' acquisition of digital textbooks. Completed by Epinion in January 2024

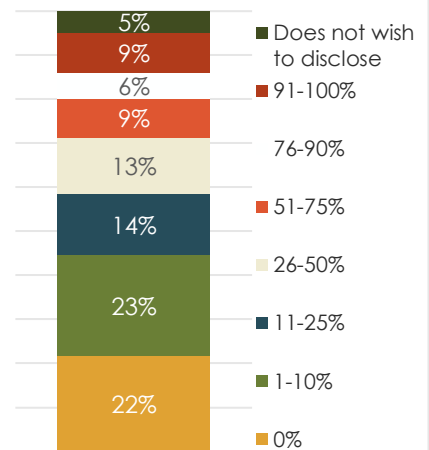

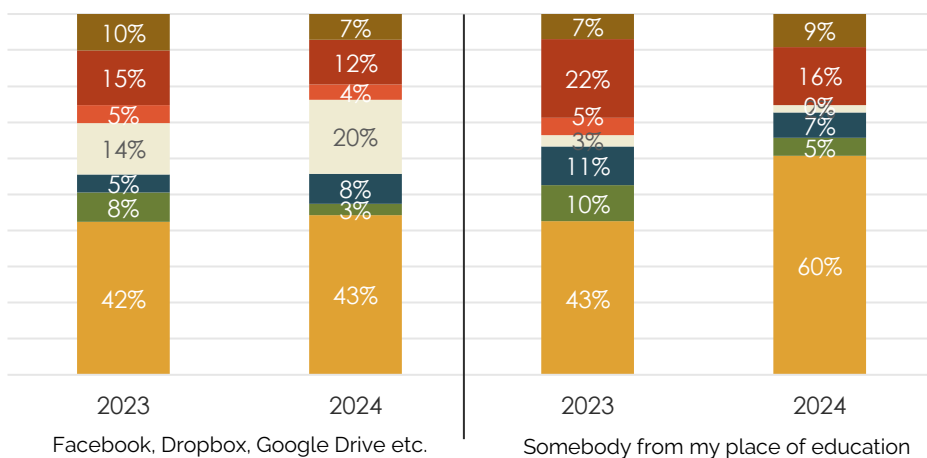
### METHODS FOR ACQUIRING DIGITAL TEXTBOOKS



What percentage of your digital textbooks would you estimate that you have acquired illegally within the last year?



Last time you used the following methods to acquire a digital textbook, who did you receive the book from?



**9%** of those who have a personal Nota membership state that they have illegally used their membership to redistribute one or more files to people who do not have access to Nota.

*Illegal acquisition* is when the digital study book is acquired from: DBA, Gul & Gratis, Facebook, Messenger, Dropbox, Google Drive, or directly from someone from their place of education. *Unknown acquisition* cover methods that can be characterized as both legal and illegal.

The survey was conducted as web-based interviews among 716 students at a higher education institution. Data were collected in the period January 9 to January 21 2024 via online panel.
